Exhibition Terms and Conditions

- The exhibitor must ensure they provide completed exhibition labels with each work.
- **All paintings** submitted for exhibition will be listed on The Gallery website and are made available for sale exclusively for a minimum period of ten weeks. Two weeks prior to the start of the exhibition, the six weeks during and two weeks following the conclusion of the exhibition. Please note ALL works are to be for sale.
- All artworks featured in an exhibition are supplied copyright free for gallery use only for publicity on social media, The Gallery website and any printed media material.
- Watercolour and pastel works are to be glazed. Oil and acrylic paintings on board or canvas should be varnished.
- No single work of art shall exceed 63 inches tall (160cm) x 75 inches wide (190cm) or weigh more than 15kg.
- All items presented for exhibition must be fully assembled, sealed and ready to hang with suitable wire or cord. Any item considered incomplete or unsafe will not be displayed. Un-framed works on canvas must have a suitable wooden stretcher.
- Exhibits may only be arranged, hung, removed and sold by The Gallery staff.
- The Gallery reserves the right to refuse permission to exhibit any work for any reason.
- Supervision of the gallery is provided during opening hours and The Gallery is protected by CCTV and a fully comprehensive burglar alarm system at all other times. All items exhibited are fully insured under The Gallery's insurance policy.*
- All exhibits must be delivered to The Gallery no less than one week prior to the start of the exhibition.
- Storage space cannot be made available for exhibits without prior agreement. A charge will be made for any exhibits that remain uncollected three weeks after the end of the exhibition, unless arranged with The Gallery.
- A commission of 40%+ VAT will be taken from the total selling price of each artwork.
- The Gallery reserves the right to sell an exhibit at the lowest marked price.
- Proceeds from sales will be paid to the exhibitor within one week of the exhibition closing date.
